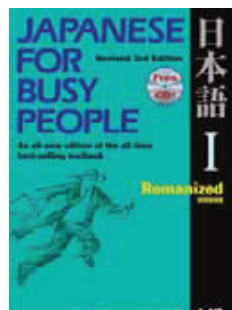
This is an intensive, one-year introductory course, but is also suitable for those who wish to work at a slower pace. Students who finish this course will have a firm grasp of language structures,
